An online webinar on 'Challenges and Solutions of Implementing the National Education Policy 2020' was held at the Regional Center Varanasi on 28th July 2025. Prof. Ram Mohan Pathak, Member of the Official Language Committee, Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi was the chief guest/key speaker, The programme was presided over by Dr. Upendra Nabh Tripathi, Regional Director, IGNOU Regional Centre Varanasi, and coordinated by Assistant Regional Director Dr. Dev Narayan Pathak.

Prof. Ram Mohan Pathak, stated that the main objective of the National Education Policy 2020 is to bring about extensive changes in the education system in India so that it can be more just, inclusive, and qualitative. This is because its primary objectives include the universalization of education, quality education, multi-disciplinary education, skill-based education, teacher training, improvement in higher education, the use of technology, inclusive education, equity in education, and enhancement of the assessment system, among others. Along with this, internationalization can be advanced by establishing partnerships with foreign universities, attracting international students, and facilitating the exchange of students and faculty. Major challenges include teacher training, linguistic diversity, changes in the assessment system, and the gap between private and government schools, which can be addressed by investing in education, providing extensive training for teachers, promoting digital education, making educational materials available in local languages, improving the assessment system, and ensuring access to education for socially and economically disadvantaged children.

Dr. Upendra Nabh Tripathi, Regional Director informed the audiences that IGNOU has been in the forefront in implementing the recommendations of NEP-2020. IGNOU has already launched the Four Year Undergraduate programmes, Choice Based Credit System is already there in IGNOU. With its variety of modular programmes IGNOU is providing its students an opportunity to exit with Post Graduate Diploma. All the programmes of IGNOU have been updated as per the requirements of NEP-2020.

Dr. Sanjay Kumar, ARD paid the vote of thanks to all participants' students and dignitaries. Among the participants were RC Officials and staff and Coordinator, Assistant Coordinators of Study Centres and Academic Counselors and students of PG programmes.
